

This Malbec offers aromas of plum, cherry and subtle oak notes, with fruity plum and raspberry flavors. The finish is fresh and fruit-forward, with a memorable personality.

Sauvigon Blanc

Smoky aromatics, with flint, bitter lemon citrus, grapefruit and suggestions of tropical fruit salad. Rich, fleshy palate with good mouth feel, texture and harmony. Flavours of yellow citrus, currant, stonefruit and sweet herbs

Château Martinet, Saint-Emilion, Bordeaux, France

Grenache, Syrah

This red wine will charm you with its notes of cherries, crushed black fruits, herbs, and slightly woody. The well-defined tannins result in a harmonious finish. Hints of undergrowth, vanilla and dark berries in the nose. Well-rounded on the palate, with elegant tannins paving the way for a smooth, long-lasting finish with not the slightest hint of harshness.

South Africa's most popular white grape variety, fresh and crisp Sauvignon blanc is very rarely oaked, making it an easy-drinking option. Widely speaking, there are two styles of Sauvignon blanc – the greener, grassier style with aromas of asparagus and green pepper, and a tropical-fruit style with hints of guava and granadilla.

Travel to any wine region in the world, and you'll find at least one vineyard growing Chardonnay. It's a wine that can be simple or regal, aged for many years or consumed immediately. The Chardonnays from South Africa range from steely wines with a clean, citrusy focus to heavily oaked ones with a rich, buttery consistency.

Pinot Grigio

This refreshing white wine with a well structured mid-palate showcases the great potential of Pinot Grigio from South Africa. A delicious drinking wine for aperitivo, antipasto and seafood.

Aromas of apricot and ripe peach with nutty and floral hints.

WHITE BLENDS

South African wineries are the most innovative when it comes to white blends. It is also where our vineyards are earning the highest international acclaim. These wines have a high average rating of perceived quality, they have the ability to age and often show the terroir. Winemakers can create distinctive blends using the diversity of the viticulture of the Western Cape. Expect Bordeaux-style blends of Sauvignon blanc and Sémillon or Mediterranean-style blends with Viognier, white Grenache, Rousanne, Marsanne and very old Chenin vines.

ROSÉ

This wine with its pink hue is not only appealing on the eye, but is normally quite light and very refreshing. The pink colour comes from the limited amount of skin contact in the wine making process, dry Rosé pairs with Carpaccio, whereas the off-dry, sweeter wines pair well with lightly-spiced dishes.

South African Cabernet Sauvignon shows classical characteristics of blackcurrant, lead pencil and firm tannins, flavours that blend well to make for a full bodied wine. For a wonderful combination, pair a Cabernet Sauvignon with red meat.

Flavours of plum, black-currant and fig paste with a firm line of graphite adding a luxurious dimension to the palate.

This wine boasts a generous nose of graphite, blackcurrants and dusty herbs. Elegant dark fruits and an intense perfumed nose makes this icon truly special. A fine grain of tannin gives tension and grip to this elegant Stellenbosch King.

Flavours of cedarwood and pencil shavings. The palate is elegant and restrained, with a firm tannin structure.

MERLOT

A soft fruit with gentle tannins creates a very popular varietal. Once barrel fermented or aged, a Merlot can become a more serious wine with vanilla and spice flavours. Merlot pairs well with the Springbok Carpaccio or Rack of Lamb.

Flavours of crushed pomegranate, juicy plums are complimented by a sweet spiciness and smooth lingering finish.

Good acidity lends to outstanding freshness with a well integrated ripe and seductive tannin structure.

This luscious and opulent wine, with balanced sweetness and full-bodied richness on the palate is soft and approachable with dark cherries, coco, cinnamon and a hint of hazelnut.

Violet and fynbos aromas lead to black cherry, capsicum, and subtle oak on the palate framed by granular, layered tannins.

Ripe red fruit flavours follow on the palate supported by a firm tannin structure and fresh acidity.

SHIRAZ / SYRAH

Shiraz or Syrah with its inherent spiciness and combinations of smokiness and red summer berries make for a well-rounded, very enjoyable red wine. Hints of leather and fynbos linger in the glass.

Enjoy this wine with oxtail or Caraffa's famous fillet gorgonzola.

Creamy red fruit elegance on the nose, with delicate violets, tobacco leaf, leather, black olive salinity, charcuterie, and a whisper of white pepper spice. A poised palate of crisp red fruit, savoury olive and sweet spice, lifted by fresh herbs and soft, fine tannins on a bright, floral finish.

PINOT NOIR

This grape varietal is known as one of the most volatile grapes, A Pinot Noir is a light 'gentle' red wine that is complex and intense. Always a good pairing with porcini and carbonara pasta.

These cool south-facing Pinot Noir vineyards are located at altitude on the foothills of the Groenlandberg mountain. Treated gently in the cellar under cool fermentation conditions. Delicate bright red cherry fruit and careful use of oak.

La Brune, The Valley, Elgin

460

A Pinot Noir that embodies the best of Elgin's cool-climate terroir. Vivid tart cherry notes, Savory undertones and a subtle earthy complexity that lingers on the palate.

Ghost Corner Cape, Elim

650

Aromas of wild strawberry, brambleberry, cranberry, black olive and bruised rosemary herbal notes.

Ataraxia, Hemel en Aarde

725

Ataraxia, a serene state of mind, free of worry and preoccupation. A compellingly seductive bouquet of red cherries, pomegranate, delicate forest floor and a hint of spice and new oak.

PINOTAGE

Dr Perold of Stellenbosch created a hybrid seed of Pinot Noir and Cinsault, to create the uniquely South African Pinotage. Pinotage pairs perfectly with Caraffa's pepper fillet, as well as the lamb rump or Osso Buco when available.
