Fontana Candida, Frascati Bernini, Latium, Italy **380**

Malvasia Bianca di Candia, Trebbiano Toscano, Malvasia del Lazio

Fontana Candida Frascati has a bright, pale straw colour; delicate fragrance of wild flowers and fruit, especially hawthorn and Golden Delicious apples. Dry flavour, soft and fruity. Fresh lively character. Elegant, mildly aromatic aftertaste of almonds.

Tenuta Aquilaia, Vermentino Maremma Toscana, Tuscany, Italy **475**

Vermentino

Nectarine, litchi, pomegranate and greengage notes. Flavours of pine nut and asparagus all expressed on a canvass of flinty petrichor and elegant acids.

Zaccagnini, Pinot Grigio, Abruzzo, Italy **495**

Pinot Grigio

This Pinot Grigio has a pale yellow colour with green nuances; very delicate bouquet, fragrant, aromatic, very fresh and well-balanced with typical nuances of fruit rinds, orange peel and pear skins.

Renzo Masi, Chianti Riserva, Tuscany, Italy **420**

Sangiovese, Canaiolo

The nose offers supple fragrances of almonds and violets. The wine is crisp and dry in the mouth, well structured, with a lovely, velvety texture.

Domini Veneti, Valpolicella Classico Superiore, Veneto, Italy **515**

Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella

Bright ruby red. Intense and persistent, with fruity aromas of cherry and plum, floral notes of violets and a touch of spiciness from black pepper. Fresh and fruity, with a poised balance between structure and body on the palate, with a harmonious finish brought about by perfect acidity and elegant tannins on the palate.

Zaccagnini, Montepulciano D'Abruzzo, Italy **525**

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo

Intense deep violet. Aromas of plums and ripe blackberry. On the palate, it shows clear breed: each sip delivers a mouthful of ripe berries, leather and black pepper with subtle hints of oregano, dried herbs, and a touch of vanilla. It is full-bodied and robust, with a perfect integration of tannins and wood, all leading to a dry, supple finish.

Fontanafredda, Dolcetto Briccotondo, Piedmont, Italy **560**

Dolcetto

The colour is a clear, ruby-red wine with violet highlights. Its vinous bouquet is fruity, very intense and rather attractive and persistent. Nicely dry, well-balanced and velvety, with clear flavours of black cherry and liquorice, subtle overtones of prune and black pepper and a pleasant, light aftertaste of almonds.

Ca' Bianca Barolo, Piedmont, Italy **1250**

Nebbiolo

Garnet, tending towards dark blue; elegant and ethereal bouquet of vanilla, wild cherries, cloves, dried wild rose petals and clean woodland undergrowth; traces of leather can also be detected. On the palate, soft tannins, juicy, with ripe sweetness extending through the finish. Shows fine harmony and length, ending with an elegant aftertaste of liquorice.

Ruby red colour with a nice and inviting rosé froth. A pleasant and youthful acidity, the taste is clean and smooth with a nice sweet and fruity nose.

Valdo, Prosecco DOC, Extra Dry, Valdobbiadene, Italy **385** 🍷

Light straw yellow in colour with greenish reflections. Fruity bouquet of ripe apples, and acacia flowers. Fruity with a bright, refreshing and zesty finish.

Ferrari Brut, Trento, Trentino, Italy **715**

Harmonious and well-balanced, with a faint suggestion of ripe fruit and attractive hints of crusty bread.

Ferrari Rosé, Trento, Trentino, Italy **905**

Fresh and fruity, with a touch of mellowness: the flavour of sweet almonds is supported by an acidulous vein that is extraordinarily appealing.

WINES OF THE WORLD

No time for a wine vacation? Maybe you want to broaden your wine horizons or just stop getting confused every time you stare at the store shelf trying to pick the perfect bottle of wine. We have gathered a few, well-priced gems to give you some insight of what other countries are doing.

Kia Ora, Sauvignon blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand **450**
Intensely perfumed, this zesty and fresh Marlborough Sauvignon blanc is a perfect introduction to the famed style of the region.

Domaine du Margalleau, Vouvray, Val de Loire, France **465**
Chenin blanc
fresh and mineral delight in youth. Citrus, grapefruit, apple blossom, flinty aromas lead on to flavours of lemons and limes, green apple and onto a lingering flinty minerality in a seductive finish.

Trapiche Oak Cask, Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina **515**
Purple hues, the nose offers up "pain grille", mineral overtones, plums and black cherry notes with a touch of black pepper. The palate is soft and round, with ripe, saturated berry flavours. Trapiche Malbec Oak Cask finishes spicy and full, with chewy, ripe tannins.

Marquis de Mons, Margaux, Bordeaux Left Bank, France **795**
Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot
This crimson coloured wine shows aromas of strawberry, raspberry and violet on the nose. The palate, full and rounded, reveals a remarkable balance, supported by good acidity which gives it freshness. And indulgent wine, easy to drink, characterized by its good balance.

CHAMPAGNE

"I only drink champagne when I'm happy, and when I'm sad. Sometimes I drink it when I'm alone. When I have company, I consider it obligatory. I trifle with it if I am not hungry and drink it when I am. Otherwise I never touch it—unless I'm thirsty." - *Lily Bollinger*

Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label, Brut Reims, France **1600** **900**

Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label manages to reconcile two opposing factors - strength and silkiness - and to hold them in perfect balance with aromatic intensity and a lot of freshness. This consistent power to please makes it ideal as an aperitif, and perfect as the Champagne to enjoy with a meal.

Mumm Rosé, Brut, France **1650**
The power and structure of Pinot Noir is delicately balanced with the elegance of Chardonnay and the fruitiness of Meunier. A portion of red wine brings intensity and notes of forest fruits and spice to this elegant blend to create a brut rosé champagne that is at once light, intense, and fresh.

Moët & Chandon Nectar Impérial, Demi-Sec, France **1650**
Lively and generous Nectar Impérial distinguishes itself by its tropical fruitiness, its richness on the palate and its crisp finish, that instantly surprise and delight.

Bollinger Special Cuvee, Brut, France **1850**
A subtle combination of structure, length and vivacity; bubbles like velvet; pear, brioche and spicy aromas, notes of fresh walnut combination of structure, length and vivacity; bubbles like velvet; pear, brioche and spicy aromas, notes of fresh walnut.

Dom Perignon Blanc, 2010, France **6000**
The luminous sweetness of tropical fruit - green mango, melon, pineapple - instantly shines. It then cedes to more temperate notes, the tingle of orange zest, the mist of a mandarin orange. The wine breathes, revealing its freshness. The bloom after the rain. A tactile sensation of peony, jasmine and lilac. The wine immediately imposes its ample presence, full and massive. A sappy sensation dominates as the tactile is rapidly overtaken by the aromatic. The body unfolds: generous, firm and controlled. Then it contracts, letting the wine vibrate with spices and pepper. The energy is sustained to a scintillating, saline finish.

CAP CLASSIQUE

The South African answer to Champagne. Cap Classique or CC refers to a sparkling wine which has undergone a second fermentation process in the bottle in which it is sold.

Bright lime green colour with rich aromas of fresh limes, green apples, pears and lemon zest on the nose. Delicately balanced flavours of succulent citrus, brioche and spice combines with yeasty complexity, broadening the palate with layered textures and leading to a long finish.

SAUVIGNON BLANC

South Africa's most popular white grape variety, fresh and crisp Sauvignon blanc is very rarely oaked, making it an easy-drinking option. Widely speaking, there are two styles of Sauvignon blanc – the greener, grassier style with aromas of asparagus and green pepper, and a tropical-fruit style with hints of guava and granadilla.

Durbanville Hills, Durbanville, Cape Town

Citrus, passion fruit, gooseberries, guava with a hint of herbaceous notes. Medium-bodied wine with a mix bowl of tropical fruit flavours, citrus and ends with a sweet fruity sensation.

Bouchard Finlayson, Walker Bay

Our mature vineyards are planted on heavy shale clay soils, and with their location less than five kilometers from the Indian Ocean, the cool maritime terroir is ideal for crafting expressions of Sauvignon blancs defined by minerality, freshness and complexity.

Ataraxia, Hemel-en-Aarde, Cape Coast

This wine flavours individuality and signature cool-climate minerality ahead of pure, pungent fruit, but still exhibits a majestic melange of tropical fruits, granadilla and pink grapefruit aromas with just a hint of ripe gooseberries. These are effortlessly reflected on the palate and are complemented by a lively acidity which underpins a classy structure and texture. A wine of substantial poise, length and charm.

Life from Stone derives its name from the incredibly rocky soils in which it is grown. Every year the vineyard battles against nature in order to produce highly concentrated, powerful wines with a flinty, mineral character true to the quartz rock in which it is grown.

Tokara, Reserve, Elgin

The wine displays a light straw colour with brilliant green edge. Aromas of green apple and lime juice, gooseberry and blackcurrent. Freshness on the palate and green apple flavours.

Diemersdal, Winter Ferment, Cape Town

A new world style of Sauvignon blanc. The wine has intense aromas of gooseberries, tropical fruit and sweet-grapefruit with a core of minerality.

CHENIN BLANC *A.K.A. Steen*

Up there, with the world's finest. It's a little known fact, but a fact all the same, that South African Chenin blanc wines are among the world's finest. The most widest planted variety in South Africa, producing an arsenal of different styles of wine.

Leeuwenkuil, Swartland

A refined and racy offering with vibrant aromas of green apple and tropical fruit. Its good minerality leads to a wonderfully fresh finish.

CHARDONNAY

Chardonnay is the most popular white wine on earth and, more recently, it has also become the most divisive. Travel to any wine region in the world, and you'll find at least one vineyard growing Chardonnay. It's a wine that can be simple or regal, aged for many years or consumed immediately. The Chardonnays from South Africa range from steely wines with a clean, citrusy focus to heavily oaked ones with a rich, buttery consistency.

Wild Yeast Chardonnay is fermented using the native, wild yeasts that occur naturally on the skins of the grapes. This unwooded Chardonnay presents itself with tropical fruit aromas that reveal notes of ripe pineapple and pear on the palate.

WOODED

La Bri, Franschhoek

355

Clean and precise, this wine embraces the fresh flavours of young pineapple, peaches and creamy lemon with the nuttiness of freshly baked biscuits all offset against a backdrop of a crisp apple palate. Aged in French oak for 10 months.

Jordan, Barrel Fermented, Stellenbosch

475

A variety of chardonnay clones planted on different slopes, harvested at different ripening levels and all of it fermented and matured in French oak barrels. These practices help to achieve natural balance and allows for different textural components which we then blend to achieve finesse and complexity. Bold and graceful with fragrances of lemon biscuit and overripe oranges.

Creation, The Glen, Hemel-en-Aarde, Cape South Coast

Only 600 bottles produced. Produced by Glen Martin - 4th generation winemaker (when qualified) in the Martin & Finlayson family. Wild yeast fermentation with classic Burgundian struck match notes, wonderful poise & complexity. Savoury depths, and a taunt, saline finish.

A wine that boasts intense aromas of apricot, with hints of rose petal. With lingering flavours of apricot and sundrenched peach.

Oak Valley, Stone & Steel, Riesling, Elgin

A wine grown high up on the foothills of the Groenlandberg in the cool climate of Elgin grown in stony soils and fermented in stainless steel resulting in a stunning tropical, mineral fruit bomb.

Cederberg, Bukkettraube, Cederberg

240 

A floral Bukkettraube with notes of chamomile and white blossom aromas. Hints of apricot and honey dew follows through on the palate. Semi-sweet that leads to a creamy finish.

WHITE BLENDS

South African wineries are the most innovative when it comes to white blends. It is also where our vineyards are earning the highest international acclaim. These wines have a high average rating of perceived quality, they have the ability to age and often show the terroir. Winemakers can create distinctive blends using the diversity of the viticulture of the Western Cape. Expect Bordeaux-style blends of Sauvignon blanc and Sémillon or Mediterranean-style blends with Viognier, white Grenache, Roussanne, Marsanne and very old Chenin vines.

Jordan Chameleon White, Stellenbosch

Sauvignon blanc, Chardonnay

Showcasing the broad fruit spectrum found in the Winelands, initial forward Cape green fig flavours follows through to a layered palate of ruby grapefruit and winter melon glacé.

Bouchard Finlayson, Blanc de Mere, Cape South Coast

Weisser Riesling, Viognier, Chardonnay

A blend of Weisser Riesling, Viognier and Chardonnay. Delicate peach and floral flavours are in perfect harmony with citrus-infused waxy fullness. The wine flows easily from a bright and clean entry to the long, tangy finish. Invigorating acidity gives structure to well-rounded mid-palate.

Viognier, Roussanne

Fun with finesse. A finely nuanced wine, artfully blended to offer vivacity as well as elegance and finesse.

ROSÉ

This wine with its pink hue is not only appealing on the eye, but is normally quite light and very refreshing. The pink colour comes from the limited amount of skin contact in the wine making process, dry Rosé/Blanc de Noirs pair with Carpaccio, whereas the off-dry, sweeter wines pair well with lightly-spiced dishes.

Theuniskraal, Moscato Rosé, Tulbagh

Brilliant rosy pink. Aromas of candy floss and strawberries with a floral background. Fresh and crisp on the palate with a complexity of fruit flavours and a lingering aftertaste.

Durbanville Hills, Merlot Rosé, Durbanville, Cape Town

Grapefruit colour. Nose of raspberries and strawberry dusted with rose petals. Refreshing and light-bodied dry wine with an abundance of fresh summer berries on the palate and berry compote.

La Brune 'The Valley', Pinot Noir Rosé, Elgin

Fresh strawberries and rose petals with a clean dry, crisp red fruit.

MERLOT

A soft fruit with gentle tannins creates a very popular varietal. Once barrel fermented or aged, a Merlot can become a more serious wine with vanilla and spice flavours. Merlot pairs well with the Springbok Carpaccio or Rack of Lamb.

A medium bodied Merlot accentuated by flavours of soft sweet red and dark fruit, rounded off with silky tannins and a full mouth feel.

L'Avenir Provenance, Stellenbosch

245

An elegant and soft expression of Stellenbosch Merlot. The L'Avenir Provenance Merlot is medium-bodied, exhibiting with delicate flavours of raspberries, cherries and a touch of dark chocolate.

La Bri, Franschhoek

345

The nose is a complex mix of fresh cherries, nutmeg and cedar oak. A juicy fresh yummy palate with soft integrated tannins.

Jordan Black Magic, Stellenbosch

415

Part whole-berry fermentation and softer pump-overs extract aromas of red plums and dark bitter chocolate. French oak maturation seasons the wine to accentuate the seductive flavours and generous velvety tannins.

Creation, Hemel-en-Aarde, Cape South Coast

On the palate, rewarding dark chocolate and mocha combine with generous ripe berry flavours, supported by the firm structure derived from judicious oak maturation.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

South African Cabernet Sauvignon shows classical characteristics of blackcurrant, lead pencil and firm tannins, flavours that blend well to make for a full bodied wine. For a wonderful combination, pair a Cabernet Sauvignon with red meat.

The nose is complex and dense showing ample black fruit and a classic lead pencil and Herbes de Provence character. The intense, dark berry aromas and garrigue notes of the nose follow through onto a mid-palate which is broody and sophisticated, yet exceptionally structured with chalky tannins and integrated acidity. Hints of graphite, sage, tobacco and fennel seed linger on a smooth, vibrant finish.

Nederburg, Western Cape

225

A rich and full-bodied wine with ripe fruit, cherry and delicate oak spice flavours, velvety tannins and a lingering aftertaste.

Tokara, Stellenbosch

295

This wine has a beautiful garnet colour. Berry aromas, red currant and blueberries on the nose. Palate is packed with sweet berry fruit, dark chocolate with hints of dried herbs on the finish.

Lanzerac, Stellenbosch,

455

This classic Cabernet shows inviting flavours of blackberry and young berry with hints of cocoa, almond and cedar. A full-bodied wine with excellent balance on the palate and a smooth lingering aftertaste.

La Bri, Limited Release, Stellenbosch

575

This Limited Release Cabernet is only made in exceptional years. 2009 (5 star), 2012 (90 points), 2015 (93 points). Only 1433 bottles of this current vintage were produced.

Boekenhoutskloof, Stellenbosch

795


The abundant red and blackberry fruit of the nose follows through with spicy notes of nutmeg, cinnamon and cloves, with hints of molasses, espresso and fine cocoa adding to the complexity of a layered, generous, powerful palate. The medium-bodied mid-palate is structured and concentrated, yet supple, elegant and lithe with its abundance of pure, lush, poised fruit, balanced with mouthwatering, bright acidity and ultra-fine, polished tannins.

SHIRAZ / SYRAH

Shiraz or Syrah with its inherent spiciness and combinations of smokiness and red summer berries make for a well-rounded, very enjoyable red wine. Hints of leather and fynbos linger in the glass. Enjoy this wine with oxtail or Caraffa's famous fillet gorgonzola.

This pairs well with various meat dishes, but especially grilled steaks, oxtail and Caraffa's roasted rack of lamb.
